I wish to renominate Daniel Ellsberg for the 2019 Nobel Peace Prize. I refer to the many fine earlier nominations by Marit Arnstad, MP, <http://www.nobelwill.org?tab=8#ellsberg2>

It is just amazing with what amounts of energy and force Mr. Ellsberg continues to let the world benefit from his vision. Right now, as I hand in this nomination, Ellsberg is on a grand whistlestop tour of Europe, giving interviews in London, as well as speeches. Yesterday, in Stockholm, he received the Olof Palme Award, and today, on Jan 31, he was lobbying in the Swedish Parliament, supporting the efforts of the previous winner ICAN to have countries sign and ratify last year's U.N. treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons. Next he moves on to Berlin on Feb. 5th, and then the Munich Security Conference.

I refer to earlier editions (paperback edition) of his book, The Doomsday Machine: Confessions of a Nuclear War Planner. He was arrested August 6th, Hiroshima Day, 2018, for obstructing entry into Livermore Nuclear Weapons Design Lab. Ellsberg is known as an eminent speaker and would like few others be able to use the Nobel award efficiently to serve Nobel's great vision of a global co-operative security system.
